

Guidelines for Final Camera-Ready Paper Submission

Authors are requested to submit the Camera-Ready paper in EDAS under the track 'Camera Ready Paper' within the deadline as mentioned in the conference website <https://icort.in>

- ✓ Before submitting, Authors are requested to ensure that the paper should strictly follow the IEEE guidelines. Suggestions for improvement/corrections (if any) as mentioned in the reviewers' comments MUST be incorporated in the paper before submission.
- ✓ Authors are also requested to submit the IEEE e-Copyright in respect of all the authors of the paper.
- ✓ Authors are also requested to check the paper in IEEE PDF eXpress for any errors and ensure that the PDF file is error free and is of version 1.4.
- ✓ Above requirements are MANDATORY for acceptance of the final camera-ready paper. Failing to comply with these will cause rejection of the paper.
- ✓ At least One of the authors of the paper MUST register for the conference. Follow the registration link provided in the website.
- ✓ Due to the No Show policy of the conference, at least one registered author should present the paper during the conference from 6-8 March 2025. Failing this, the paper will not be considered for publication in the proceedings. The presentation schedule will be published in the website after final acceptance of the Camera-Ready Paper.
- ✓ The presentation file and the colour passport size photograph of all the authors (for publication in souvenir) are required to be submitted in EDAS in the same track.

As the submission of the Final Camera-Ready paper is over EDAS, authors are requested to check the deadline and submit the paper accordingly. Papers submitted over email or request for submission beyond deadline will not be accepted.

Steps by step instructions:

- ✓ Download IEEE conference template (Microsoft word/ Latex) from <https://www.ieee.org/conferences/publishing/templates.html>

- ✓ Prepare the paper as per the format and guideline. Include authors names and affiliation in the final camera-ready paper. Do not include any header, footer or page number in the manuscript. The IEEE copyright string at the bottom of 1st page (XXX-X-XXXX-XXXX-X/XX/\$XX.00 ©20XX IEEE) should also be removed.
- ✓ Revise the paper as per the comments of the reviewers and strictly adhere to the IEEE format.
- ✓ Submit the IEEE PDF eXpress compliant manuscript (in pdf) in EDAS under the field “Submit Final Camera Ready Paper” under the track named “Initial Full Paper Submission” and make sure the paper title, authors name etc. in the manuscript match the names as provided in EDAS.
- ✓ Create the manuscript pdf either by own pdf creator tool or use IEEE PDF Express Tool.
- ✓ In the former case, make sure the PDF does not have any bookmarks, form fields, links (URLs), PDF annotation, not embedded fonts, stamped with copyright or header, scanned image, encrypted file and print-only file. Once the pdf file is created, check for compatibility in IEEE PDF eXpress site. Go to <https://ieeepdf-express.org/Account/Login> and create login account by providing conference ID as ‘64008X’ and email id. After logging in and providing basic information go to Dashboard. In Dashboard, ‘create new title’ and upload the PDF. After successful checking, the PDF file can be downloaded and mailed to the email address.
- ✓ Directly convert the doc file to PDF file in IEEE PDF eXpress site by uploading the doc file in ‘new title’ form as described above.
- ✓ Transfer IEEE Electronic Copyright Form (ECF) in EDAS. Before uploading the paper, EDAS will redirect to IEEE eCF site. Provide all the necessary information and complete the form before submission.
- ✓ Register your paper in ICORT-2025 site <https://icort.in> with full payment.
- ✓ Session information and presentation guidelines will be shared subsequently. Please visit <https://icort.in> for regular updates.
